The emergency petition must be filed at the same time as or after a petition for a regular conservator or full guardian with conservator powers is filed. Form **[PG-100](#)** can be used to ask for a non-emergency guardian for an adult and form **[PG-104](#)** can be used to ask for a non-emergency conservator for an adult. There is no current form for a request for a child.
