**ORDER ON AFFIDAVIT OF ATTORNEY APPOINTED
UNDER SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL RELIEF ACT**

The court finds that the attorney appointed to this case was:

- able to contact** the servicemember or assure that the servicemember had actual notice of the lawsuit. The attorney is dismissed from their duties. The servicemember:
 - does not wish to move for a stay.
 - does wish to move for a stay. The stay is:
 - Denied.
 - Granted. A stay of (at least 90)_____ days will be imposed.

- unable to contact** the servicemember or assure that the servicemember had actual notice of the lawsuit. In attempting to contact the **servicemember** the court finds that the attorney:
 - exercised due diligence.**
The court grants a stay of proceedings for (at least 90)_____ days. The attorney is dismissed from their duties.
 - did not exercise due diligence.**
The court orders the attorney to use further diligence in attempting to contact the servicemember. The attorney shall prepare an affidavit setting forth the efforts made under this appointment, court form CIV-661. Time to oppose any motion is extended 40 days from the date of distribution.
