AND APPOINTMENT OF ATTORNEY OR GAL**
[AS 18.15.385(f)-(g); .392]

Notice of Hearing. A petition was filed asking the court for an order to isolate or quarantine you because a medical officer from the State of Alaska determined that you may have been exposed to a contagious disease. A hearing about the petition has been scheduled as follows:

The State of Alaska may ask to postpone the hearing for a short period of time. You will be notified if that happens.

Notice of Rights During Hearing. You have the following rights at the hearing:

1. The right to be represented by a lawyer and if you cannot financially afford one, one can be appointed for you;
2. The right to attend the hearing by telephone, or in person if allowed by the court;
3. The right to have an interpreter if you do not understand English;
4. The right to have the hearing open or closed to the public;
5. The right to view and make copies of all applications, petitions, and reports in the court file about your case;
6. The right to have the rules of evidence and civil procedure applied so as to provide for informal but efficient presentation of evidence;
7. The right to present evidence on your own behalf;
8. The right to call experts and other witnesses to testify on your behalf; and
9. The right to cross-examine witnesses who testify against you.

Appointment of Attorney/Guardian Ad Litem. The court appoints:

- The Office of the Public Defender as counsel for the respondent in this matter.
- The Office of Public Advocacy as *guardian ad litem* for the respondent in this matter.
