PROTECTIVE CUSTODY ORDER
[AS 18.15.375(d); and .385(h)]

TO ANY PEACE OFFICER FOR THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 1. Pursuant to AS 18.15.375, the court issued an *ex parte* for testing, examination, or screening of the respondent. The date of that order was _____. It expires five days later on _____.
- Pursuant to AS 18.15.385, the court issued an order for quarantine or isolation of the respondent. The date of that order was _____. It expires on _____.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 2. You shall detain the respondent in protective custody in a location as directed by the Alaska Department of Health and Social Safety, Division of Public Health (the Department), or as provided in the order referenced in paragraph 1 above.
- 3. Except as provided in paragraph 4 below, this protective custody order shall remain in effect for the duration of the order referenced in paragraph 1. If the respondent leaves the designated location, you shall detain the respondent and return the respondent to the designated location.
- 4. Respondent shall be released if at any time a qualified representative of the Department finds that grounds for detention of respondent no longer exist or the order referenced in paragraph 1 expires, whichever occurs first.
- 5. The following shall be served on the respondent by peace officer:
 - This *Order*, the *Ex Parte Order*, the *Application for Ex Parte Order*, and a blank *Request for Hearing to Vacate the Ex Parte Order*.
 - This *Order*, the *Petition for Quarantine or Isolation*, and the *Order for Quarantine or Isolation*.
