CHARGE: AS 04.16.050, Possession, Control, or Consumption of Alcohol by Person Under Age 21

 - Defendant must enroll in and pay for the Kenai _____ Alcohol Safety Action Program (ASAP). Defendant must submit to evaluation by the program within 10 days, and pay for and successfully complete any education or treatment recommended by this program.
 - ASAP costs may be credited to fine.
 - This program may require up to _____ days of in-patient treatment. If such treatment is required, defendant may ask the court to review this requirement by filing a written request for review within seven days after being referred to in-patient treatment. The request must specifically state the reasons for requesting review.
 - Defendant may not consume inhalants or possess or consume controlled substances or alcoholic beverages, except as provided in AS 04.16.051(b).
