


ALCOHOL RESTRICTION AND THE MARKED DL/ID



THE BOTTOM LINE:
DUI/Refusals: If D is ordered not to drink alcohol as part of a DUI/Refusal, then D can't buy alcohol either during that time. D's license and ID must be surrendered and are subject to cancellation. When D gets a new license or ID, it has to be marked to show that D can't buy alcohol. D can apply for a new DL when the drinking restriction ends.
Non-DUI/Refusals: If D is ordered not to drink alcohol as part of a non-DUI offense, then D can't buy alcohol during that time. When D gets a new ID, it has to be marked to show that D can't buy alcohol. D can apply for a new ID when the drinking restriction ends.
