


# PROTECTION FROM FINANCIAL ABUSE

## 20-Day *Ex Parte* Protective Orders (AS 13.26.207)

**Persons Eligible to Petition:**

AS 13.26.180(a) includes a list of persons eligible to petition. It is interpreted for purposes of these diagrams and the court forms to be illustrative (as in, "including but not limited to"), and not exclusive. The conclusion is that anybody is eligible to petition. Below is the illustrative list from the statute (red lettering shows changes to .180 in SB-86):

- Protected person
- **Protected person's attorney**
- **Protected person's other legal rep**
- Any person interested in protected person's estate, affairs, or welfare
  - Parent
  - Guardian
  - Custodian
  - **Caregiver**
  - **DHSS**
- Any person who would be adversely affected by lack of effective management of property and affairs of protected person.

(Note, AS 13.26.207 -.209 are new law from SB-86 in 2012)

**Labeling Conventions:**

PP = protected person (person needing protection)

P = petitioner (person filing petition for protection)

R = respondent (restrained person)

PO = protective order

(PG forms are Probate-Guardianship forms of the Alaska Court System)
